REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR TOWN OF
BEVERLY SHORES DRAINAGE WORK PER
SPECIFICATIONS

Sealed bids will be received by the TOWN OF BEVERLY SHORES, Porter County, Indiana at the office of the Clerk-Treasurer at the Town Administration Building, 500 Broadway, P.O. Box 38, Beverly Shores, IN 46301-0038 until 1:00 p.m. (local time) on JULY 17, 2009 for the following services by independent contractors.

DRAIN PIPE REPLACEMENT: Replacing existing drain pipe within the Town of Beverly Shores on West Fairwater Ave. as per the following specifications:

Materials supplied by contractor include:

1. 12" dual lined perforated plastic pipe with sock, approximately 900 linear ft.
2. One (1) manhole/dry well access point w/ 2' diameter removable lid @ approx 665' (access point #1)
3. One (1) manhole/dry well access point w/ 2' diameter removable lid @ approx 900' (access point #2)
4. 12" dual lined perforated plastic pipe with sock to be set in pea gravel
5. 12" dual lined perforated plastic pipe with sock to be placed in such a manner as to drain properly (pitched) from east to west so as to drain to Derby Ditch.
6. Connection shall be made to existing dry well/access pit on west end and to existing drain pipe on west end.
7. Removal and disposal of existing drain pipe
8. Replacement of road surface or driveways sections removed with compacted gravel
9. Option to be priced separate from above: One (1) spur to run to manhole/dry well access point #1 south approx 15' to pick up surface water south of West Fairwater Ave. complete with intake screen to keep large debris from drain pipe.

Work shall be performed within 60 (sixty) days of award of bid.

The written quotations should be for a "fixed price" but with operator and machine hourly rates in case the length is altered. Bidder must provide detailed materials list and bidder's experience.

All services shall be performed by the employees of the successful contractors using materials and equipment supplied by the successful contractors. Prospective bidders should contact the Town Marshal or Town Council President to make an appointment to view the area and to ask any questions about the services required prior to submitting their bids.

No bidder may withdraw a bid within a period of 60 days following the date set for receiving bids. The Town Council reserves the right to retain any and all bids for a period of not more than 60 days and said bids shall remain in full force and affect during said time. The Council further reserves the right to waive defects in bids; to waive formalities and to award the Contracts to any Bidder, all to the advantage of the Town, or to reject all bids.

BID SECURITY shall be submitted with bid proposal and be in the form of a bid bond, cashier's check or certified check payable to the Town of Beverly Shores in an amount equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the bid amount.

A CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE shall be required of the successful contractor and must contain the minimum acceptable insurance limits of \$250,000 property damage, \$300,000 per person for personal injury with a combined single limit of \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
