

Notice is hereby given the taxpayers of Porter County, Town of Burns Harbor, Indiana, that the Town Council of Burns Harbor, Indiana at 1240 North Boo Road on September 21, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. will conduct a public hearing on the budget. Following this meeting any ten or more taxpayers may object to a budget, tax rate, or tax levy by filing an objecting petition with the proper officers of the political subdivision within seven days after the hearing. The objecting petition must identify the provisions of the budget, tax rate, or tax levy that taxpayers object to. If a petition is filed, the political subdivision shall adopt with its budget a finding concerning the objections filed and testimony presented. Following the aforementioned meeting, the fiscal body will meet at 1240 North Boo Road on October 13, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. to adopt the following budget.
