

ORDINANCE 245-2011
AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BURNS
HARBOR, PORTER COUNTY, INDIANA,
AMENDING TOWN CODE

WHEREAS, the Sanitary Board of the Town of Burns Harbor, Indiana, has recommended that the Town recover the expenses associated with providing utility locating services; and WHEREAS, the Town Council concurs in the recommendation of the Sanitary Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BURNS HARBOR, PORTER COUNTY, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Section 4-10 of the Burns Harbor Town Code shall be and is hereafter amended to read as follows:

Sec. 4-10. INSPECTIONS.

After the issuance of any building permit, the Building Commissioner shall make, or shall cause to be made, inspections of the work being done as are necessary to insure full compliance with the provisions of this ordinance and the terms of the permit. Re-inspections of work found to be incomplete or not ready for inspection are subject to assessment of reinspection fees as prescribed in this code.

In the case of any inspection requiring the location of public utilities, the person, firm or corporation requesting the location inspection shall pay the costs of the inspection to the Town, as shall be set forth in the current schedule on file with the office of the Clerk-Treasurer. Provided, that no such location inspection fee shall be charged for location inspection requests performed in conjunction with residential building and improvement location permits.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication as required by law.
