The fines as set forth in this schedule shall be only applicable in the event of a first violation by defendant. Any subsequent violations of the same ordinance shall be subject to the general penalty provisions of this Code, found in section 1-8, which provide for a fine of not more than \$2,500.00 for a second or subsequent violation of an ordinance, with the exception of violation ordinances that apply to traffic regulation or parking. Any code violation that is not listed above without fees stated in Town of Porter Code Book will have a minimum fine of \$50.00 for first offense.
