Notice is hereby given that the Town Of Porter, Indiana, (Owner) will receive sealed bids at the office of the Clerk-Treasurer, Town Hall Building, 303 Franklin Street, Town Of Porter, Indiana, 46304 until the hour of 3:00 P.M. (local time), on Wednesday, December 21, 2011, for the following:

DOWNTOWN SANITARY SEWER  
REHABILITATION PROJECT

Bids will be opened immediately thereafter in the Porter Town Hall Meeting Room.

Work to be performed shall include the rehabilitation of approximately 10,500 LF of existing main line sanitary sewer and approximately 7,700 LF of existing sanitary sewer service lateral by a Cured-In-Place-Pipe (CIPP) method. The main line sanitary sewer to be rehabilitated range in size from 8" to 15" in diameter.

The Bidding Documents are on file and available for public inspection or purchase during regular working hours in the office of Haas & Associates, 526 Franklin Sq., Michigan City, Indiana, phone (219) 872-9407. There will be a nonrefundable charge of Sixty Dollars (\$60.00) for every set of bidding documents. Bidding Documents are also available for public inspection at the Porter Town Hall.

Bids must include a completed Form 96 (Revised 2010), as prescribed by the State Board of Accounts, accompanied by a Certified Check or Bid Bond in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the bid. Additional requirements may be discussed in detail in the Bidding Documents.

All bidders shall visit the project site to become familiar with site conditions prior to making a bid.

Work under this project is subject to the Prevailing Wage Rates established by the State of Indiana, Department of Labor.

The Contractor shall appoint a company executive to assume the responsibility for the implementation of the requirements, terms and conditions of bid conditions.

A pre-bid conference will be held at the Town Hall Building, 303 Franklin Street, Town Of Porter, Indiana, 46304, on Thursday, December 15, 2011, at 3:00 P.M. (Local Time), for all bidders planning to bid as General Contractor.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to accept a full or partial award of the bid or bids which, in its judgment, will be to the best interests of the Owner. Bids shall remain in effect for up to thirty (30) days after the Bid Date.
