

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-02
AN ORDINANCE OF
THE TOWN OF PORTER, INDIANA
AMENDING SECTION 1-18 OF
THE PORTER TOWN CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PORTER as follows:
Section 1. Amendment of Section 1-18. Section 1-18 shall be amended by adding the following fines to Exhibit A:

The fines as set forth in this schedule shall be only applicable in the event of a first violation by the defendant. Any subsequent violations of the same ordinance shall be subject to the general penalty provisions of this Code, found in section 1-8, which provide for a fine of not more than \$2,500.00 for a second or subsequent violation of an ordinance, with the exception of violations of ordinances that apply to traffic regulation or parking. Any code violation that is not listed above or without fees stated in Town of Porter Code Book will have minimum fine of \$50.00 for first offense.

Section 2. Conflicting Ordinances. Any Ordinance or provision of any Ordinance of the Town of Porter Code of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this Ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
