

LEGAL NOTICE

The Board of Directors of the Twin Creeks Conservancy District is inviting candidates for membership on the Board of Directors of the Conservancy District to file nominating petitions pursuant to I.C. 14-33-5-3. Three directorship positions will be voted upon at the 2018 annual meeting of the Twin Creeks Conservancy District. One directorship position is currently held by Incumbent Governing Board member Randy Greer and serves from the Old South Haven Directorship area. The election for this directorship position will be for a full four year term on the Governing Board. The second directorship position is currently held by Incumbent Board Member Mark Lippie and represents the New South Haven Subdivision directorship area. This election will be for a full four year term on the Board of Directors. The third directorship position is currently held by Incumbent Board Member Terry Cletcher and represents the Old South Haven Subdivision directorship area. This election will be for the two years remaining on the unexpired term on the Board of Directors.

Interested and qualified applicants for the either directorship positions are invited to submit a nominating petition signed by at least five (5) freeholders from within their respective directorship areas. A candidate must be a freeholder from the directorship area for which the nominating petition is filed or the nominee of a corporate freeholder. The nominating petitions must be filed pursuant to the provisions of the Indiana Conservancy Act before December 1, 2017. Nominating petitions can be filed by mailing them to the mailing address of the Twin Creeks Conservancy District which is P.O. Box 209, Wheeler, Indiana 46393. Nominating petitions that are mailed are valid only if delivered or postmarked before December 1, 2017 and if the envelope has sufficient United States Postage and is addressed to the aforementioned address.

To be qualified to hold the position of director, an individual must be qualified by knowledge and experience in matters pertaining to the development of the district. A nominee need not be a petitioner for establishment of the district. A nominee does not have to be a resident of the area of the district from which nominations are invited but must be a freeholder.
